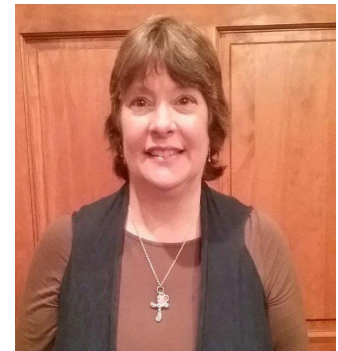

- An exclusive club for 'super Christians'
- A replacement for a person's home Church
