

The Walk to Emmaus Is:

- A place where a person learns how to become a better servant to fellow believers in Christ (Philippians 2:1-11)
- A place where a person sees the love of Christ in action
- A time of spiritual renewal and re-dedication to Christ as Lord
- An opportunity to grow as a disciple of Christ
- A place to be reminded of one's "first love", Jesus Christ
- A gift of God's love for you
- An opportunity to re-valuate your priorities in life
- A place to experience God's power and direction in your life
- A time of prayer, fellowship and communion
- An opportunity to meet new brothers and sisters in Christ
- A discipleship group to encourage you after the Walk
- A program to strengthen leaders in the local Church
- A call for unity among believers

## **What Emmaus Is Not**

The Walk to Emmaus is Not:

- A cult
- An exclusive club for 'super Christians'
- A replacement for a person's home Church
- A place to fix emotional, psychological, social and marital problems
- A reason for a person to act as if they are better than others

## **Comments about the Walk to Emmaus**

### **New Understanding**

I understand the meaning of a "living sacrifice."

· **Understanding God's love and grace are beyond our comprehension and understanding. Words, language, and knowledge are all inadequate to describe the infinite reach of God's love and grace.**

From the Parable of the Talents, Matthew 25:14-30 one servant received 5 talents, another 2 talents, and the third 1 talent. I believe that on our Emmaus Walk all of us were commissioned, charged with, and given 30 to 50 talents each! My point is not that we are so righteous and deserve more than others, for we are STILL SINNERS; the point is that we were given much, but much will be expected of us.

· Watch out for what you pray for!

I had consistently prayed for a "closer" relationship with God. I also asked God to be able to work full-time for God spreading His Word. I had envisioned that years down the road that I would be a full-time disciple, witness, teacher, writer, and lecturer to "newbees." Nurturing "Bible Basics" to new people who are new to Christ.

**· I have received a closer relationship with God, closer than I ever conceived - But I will always pray to have a closer relationship to such an awesome God. As far as working for God full-time - someday??? God has commissioned me to start working for Him full-time - TODAY. I am to work for God NOW with the resources I have right now!. My plan that I was thinking of was too small; God's plan for me that I could not have conceived was much larger than I had ever imagined!**

· What makes this gift so wonderful was that it was a shared experience with others who saw the same thing. We all saw Jesus, but we all saw Him differently.

· **My first thoughts were of unworthiness, that I did not deserve or earn this great of a gift.**

· No earthly king, president, or billionaire deserves, could earn, or buy what we received at our Emmaus Walk.

· **I thought I knew something about "Grace" but I saw "Grace" and "Love" more than I could imagine.**

· Watch out what you pray for!

· **Prayers are answered but maybe not the way we expect!**

· We often limit our prayers.

· **I was thinking too small.**

· Working Full-Time for God. - Start Now!

· **Closer Relationship with God..**
