## *Pilgrims Needed for the Men's Walk*

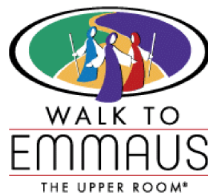


Christmas is over and we are winding down. Most of the decorations are down or we are thinking about taking them down. We have been busy. Now we look to a new year with anticipation.
