My Emmaus Journey began on Walk #12 in 1996, so I have had 22 years of Fourth Days. My life has certainly been enriched by my Emmaus experiences. Although I have no remarkable or dynamic testimony to share with you, I do have many times my Emmaus family has prayed me through many frightful episodes during this time.

It began with the births of my three grandchildren in 1997, 1999, and 2002. All three had traumatic births and we weren't sure they would make it. My mother died in 2000. My oldest sister, Sara, experienced a ruptured aneurysm and stroke in 2007 which left her paralyzed until her death in 2013. Her husband died in 2009. Their only child died in 2015. My youngest sister, Patty, was diagnosed with colon cancer in 2014. I had multiple surgeries during this time also: rotator cuff - 2009, two knee replacements - 2015, another surgery on right knee in 2016.

During each of these times, the prayers of my Emmaus family were priceless. I felt these in each situation. Just when things got really tough, I would receive a card or phone call, text or email telling me that I was loved and being lifted in prayer. I cant imagine what my life would be without Emmaus.

I have been blessed not only by the Walk itself, but I've been blessed to serve on many Emmaus teams, several Journey

teams and by attending Gatherings. Although one of my Reunion Groups no longer meets, this group of women played an important role in my life, keeping me accountable and always praying together.

In September, 2016 we received news of something that has rocked my world and changed my oldest daughter's life forever. Traci was diagnosed with Chronic Myeloid Leukemia. She has always devoted her life to serving Christ and it was difficult for me to accept and understand why this was happening to her. But again, the prayers of God's people came through and have kept us going for the past year and nine months. Although without God's intervention, she will be on chemo for the rest of her life, we have seen and continue to see God's hand at work. Words can't express how much it means to know that so many of you are still praying for our family and especially for Traci.

I appreciate so much when someone asks about her and they tell me they are praying for her. Please continue to do so. Although it is hard to understand why this has happened to her, I know her faith has never wavered.

God never leaves nor forsakes us and I'm so grateful for my Fourth Days in HIS presence.

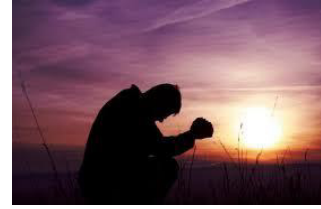
