"Honor your father and your mother, which is the first commandment with promise:

Our firstborn child, Ryles Chapman Anderson was born on January 24, 2014. God in his perfect timing blessed us with a happy, healthy son. Since his birth, now 16 months ago, I find myself telling people all the time that I had no idea what we were missing!

I wonder sometimes if the same is not true for our relationship with Jesus? As I think back, could I have imagined what God would have in store for me? Or even more so, when I think about what God still has before us in light of eternity.

Keri and I were married in 2003 and year after year we decided for one reason or another to wait to start a family. Distractions, busyness, selfishness and --most of all--the underlying fear of change and the unknown kept me wondering if fatherhood was something that I would not be very good at. God in his wisdom knew how to grow my heart. When that day came and every day since then I have been taking my own first steps in fatherhood.

***"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. And you know the way to where I am going."* John 14:1-4 ESV**

From these special verses I know that Jesus first of all wants for me not to worry, but to exchange that worry for belief. I heard recently that we should understand that not only is Jesus preparing a place for us, but at the same time he is working in our lives to prepare us for that place. Like the Israelites of Exodus, we are perhaps unaware of God's work in our lives as he prepares us for that place.

I thought about our first steps as Pilgrims as I watched my son learn to walk. To me watching Ryles take his first steps was a powerful lesson, stumbling and falling all the time at first, but unafraid and persistent none the less.

I hope and pray my first steps in following the steps of my Father are just as determined. By His grace, they can be.
