Sometimes A Blind Man Can Start a Fire! By Bruce Purcell

When my friend, David, called I was glad to hear from one of the most dedicated Christian men I have ever met. When he speaks I try to listen! You

see, David is blind. Right before the holidays, he called me to see if I had talked to Clint Blount at the Blount Boys Home over in Toombs County. David said he heard that they had some needs with the COVID virus going on and they needed a few things. Clint is Mel Blount's brother. Mel Blount who founded the Home had been an outstanding NFL player and retired in 1983. In an effort to give back what opportunities he had been given, he opened up a Boys Home in Pittsburg, PA and another one on the family farm out from Lyons, GA. The Boys Home accepts troubled young men 12-18 years old in the court system and offers these boys a place where they are taught faith in God, discipline, and hard work.

So without government help, they raise funds; however, the cost is large to feed, house, school, and have counselors on hand 24/7. So when I called Clint and asked him what he needed to help with these young men, he said their chainsaw had given up and they used a lot of firewood. They also needed a backpack blower to clean up the campus. I said, "O.K., what else do you need?" He said they really liked the meat several men had brought in the last few years. I said, "Well, we will just pray about all that." I made a few phone calls, and soon we had 400 pounds of meat, a chainsaw, and a blower!! This was mostly taken care of and paid for by my Emmaus Reunion group and Emmaus friends of men and women who all have big hearts for kids! So now the Alice Blount Academy has new tools and a lot of meat for soups, chili, and burgers. There have also been nice donations sent in from Claxton, Statesboro, and Glennville! "How Great Is Our God!" when we just pray and ask! "Sometimes a blind man can start a fire!"
