
I was determined to begin setting a Christian example for my employees and customers at the bank. I decided that every Monday morning, before opening the doors of the bank, our entire team would gather in the lobby to pray for others in the community, and to ask God to allow our customers to see Christ in us as we serve them. It set the tone for a great and productive week while encouraging our team members to share the love of Christ with customers.

When I returned to Church the Lord led me to become the Chairman of the Missions Committee. I asked our Pastor to send requests for financial and food assistance from the needy to my office, so that I could meet with them and provide financial advice on how to prioritize their expenses through effective budgeting. But more importantly, I used the time to witness to them about their need for a deep and personal relationship with Christ. We provided them with financial/food assistance, gave them a Bible, and always prayed with them prior to leaving. In almost every case, they would have tears in their eyes as they left my office. It is my hope that they left my office feeling the love of Christ.

The measure of our witness is not in immediate results. Some will plant, some will water, and some will harvest. As disciples, we are not called to be successful, but to be faithful; doing what we can, with what we have, right where we are. I challenge you to let Christ be your guide, with the talents that he has blessed you with, and be the faithful servant that He has called you to be. And on that glorious day when we stand before our Heavenly Father, He will say "Well done my good and faithful servant, well done."
